

Scholarship for Intensive Spanish Study • Application Form
Deadline November 15 for Winter Break, April 1 for Summer (Revised 10-2006: App_ILP_All)

Affiliated intensive language programs offer a limited number of awards that typically cover tuition, room and board for two weeks at their programs. Students must enroll for four weeks, live with a family, and agree to assist the Office of Study Abroad with recruitment to receive a scholarship. Applications for scholarships will only be considered if applicant has (a) obtained approval from his/her college to enroll in one of these programs, (b) completed and turned in the NMSU Study Abroad Agreement and paid the required processing fee to the Office of Study Abroad, and (c) submitted the institute's application form.

(Note: Availability of awards varies annually and may not be offered every year. Students who have previously received one of these awards are not eligible for a second award.)
